CHICHÉN ITZÁ - CENOTE - IZAMAL

Chichén Itzá one of the seven new world wonders, famous because of the political importance in the Mayan times as well as the impressive construction style, for instance of the pyramid Kukulkán. Refresh yourself with a bath in a cenote, one of the 2000 registered limestone caves on the Yucatan peninsula. In the "yellow-city" Izamal, you enter the extensive Franciscan Monastery "Ex Convento San Antonio" with the world's second largest closed atrium after the St. Peter's Square in Vatican City.
