Day - 2 Phnom Penh

PHNOM PENH FULL DAY TOUR *(B, L)*

After your breakfast at the hotel, **visit the Royal Palace. It was built in 1866 by King Norodom in the old town of Phnom Penh.** The impressive Silver Pagoda is located within the Royal Palace and part of your visit. Continue to the **National Museum which is one of Phnom Penh's genuine architectural gems**. Lunch at a local restaurant. **First stop in the afternoon is the Tuol Sleng Genocide Museum, followed by the Killing Fields of Choeung Ek, 15 km outside the city.** After this excursion into the **dark past of Cambodia, enjoy your visit to the Russian Market (Psah Tuol Thom Pong).** Here you can find a variety of products such as **antiquities, silver and gold jewelry, silk and wood carvings** as well as **T-shirts, CDs** and other **souvenirs**. Transfer back to your hotel.
