

Best Of Cambodia I Phnom Penh, Siem Reap & Sihanouk Ville

Six days, three cities and the highlights of this great country included. Discover Angkor Wat and a beautiful Sunset, after exploring Phnom Penh during a city tour and before taking some relaxing time at the beach in Sihanouk Ville.

Day - 3 Siem Reap

SIEM REAP: BAYON TEMPLE, ANGKOR WAT & BAKHENG SUNSET *(B, L)*

Today, embark on an Elephant Ride from the South Gate of Angkor Thom into the jungle to see the famous Bayon Temple which is unique for its 54 towers decorated with over 200 smiling faces of Avolokitesvara. Also see the Baphoun, the Elephant Terrace, and Terrace of the Leper King. Finish your visit with the fabulous Ta Prohm which is embraced by the roots of enormous fig trees and gigantic creepers. During the afternoon, visit the famous temple: Angkor Wat. It has been a World Heritage Site since 1992, famous for its beauty and splendor. It features the longest continuous bas-relief in the world which runs along the outer gallery walls and narrates stories from Hindu mythology. Finish the day at Bakheng Temple and enjoy a spectacular sunset view from the hill.
