



Cambodia Experience I Siem Reap & Phnom Penh

Combine the relaxed atmosphere in Phnom Penh with exploring Angkor on this short trip.

Day - 4 Phnom Penh

PHNOM PENH TOUR – DEPARTURE PHNOM PENH (B, L)

In the morning, visit the Royal Palace that was built by King Norodom in 1866, and the Silver Pagoda, located within the grounds of the Royal Palace. Then continue to visit the National Museum. This is one of Phnom Penh's true architectural gems. It houses more than 14,000 items; the World's largest collection of Khmer Art, including sculptures, ceramics, bronzes, and ethnographic objects dating from prehistoric times to periods before, during and after the Khmer Empire. Lunch is at a local restaurant. In the afternoon, visit the Tuol Sleng Genocide Museum (S21 prison). This prison was a high school, and used as a prison by Pol Pot's security forces and became the largest centre for detention and torture during the rule of the Khmer Rouge. Then visit the notorious Killing Fields "ChoeungEk" south west of Phnom Penh. This one is the site of brutal executions of more than 17,000 individuals, most of who first suffered through interrogations, torture and deprivation in Toul Sleng Prison during the Pol Pot regime (From 1975–1979).

Late afternoon, drive to the airport for your departure flight.
