### Day - 10 Yerevan

#### **AKHALTSIKHE – VARDZIA – YEREVAN (B, D)**

Discover the Vardzia Cave Complex in the morning. It was founded in the 12th-13th cc. during the reign of Giorgi III and Queen Tamar. The complex became a well fortified monastery, which had a significant role in the political, cultural, educational and spiritual life of Georgia. Continue with a photo stop at the Khertvisi Fortress, before you arrive in Yerevan and check into your hotel.
