

Northern Vietnam I Wildlife Discovery

The flora and fauna of Vietnam is unique and overwhelming! On this tour you get the chance to explore the wildlife and biodiversity of the famous Cuc National Park and to spot endangered and rare species.

Day - 5 Hanoi

NINH BINH - HANOI (B, L)

This morning after breakfast, you will depart for the site of Vietnam's first capital, Hoa Lu. Visit the temples dedicated to Emperor Dinh Tien Hoang of the Dinh Dynasty (968-80), and Emperor Le Dai Hanh of the Le Dynasty (980-1009). The ancient Hoa Lu Citadel (most of which has since been destroyed) once covered an area of three square kilometers. If time permits after visiting Hoa Lu (for the fit and healthy), take a half-hour walk up one of the surrounding limestone karst hills, the climb is rewarding with spectacular views. Enjoy a simple Vietnamese lunch at the local restaurant. This afternoon you will visit Van Long Nature Reserve for a boat trip. Covering an area of nearly 3,000 hectares, Van Long is the largest wetland nature reserve in the North of Vietnam and a 1.5 hour boat trip by traditional sampan is the perfect way to see this area. Van Long's fauna includes 39 species of birds, reptiles, amphibians and fish. Some of these species have been classified as globally endangered animals such as the white-breeched languor which can be seen occasionally early morning or late afternoon. Late afternoon transfer by road back to Hanoi (approx. 2 hours) arriving in the early evening. Check in hotel.
